About our College

Vhembe TVET College is one of the progressive TVET colleges with coherent systems and initiatives that effectively support teaching and learning. In our 60 years of existence the college has produced people of prominence in various fields of trade. Due to the vastness of the area, we have by far the most enrolled students in the college than our peers nationally. Through partnerships forged with strategic institutions like SETA's and many others like them, this has made us an institution of choice.

Vhembe TVET College was established in 1963 under the name Sibasa Ambag Bantu Skool and in 1968 it was renamed Finyazwanda Ambag Skool. In 1985 the school was again renamed Finyazwanda Trade Institute and later on Finyazwanda Technical College. Again in 1991, the College was renamed Technical College of Venda (Techniven) until 2003 when it was again changed to Vhembe FET College until 2014.

The College is now known as Vhembe TVET College and has seven campuses, namely: Makwarela, Mavhoi, Mashamba, Shingwedzi, Thengwe, Tshisimani and Musina. In addition to the seven campuses, the College recently opened Makhado Hospitality Centre which enhances the growth and expansion of access to students within Vhembe District Municipality.

We are situated in the Vhembe District Municipality, which is in the far north of the Limpopo Province, with our Central Office situated in Sibasa. The district is comprised of four municipalities, namely, Thulamela, Makhado, Lim 345 (Collins Chabane Municipality) and Musina, with the seat located in Thohoyandou. It covers 21, 000km2 or 18% of the province.

The College prides itself with footprints it has with all local municipalities within Vhembe District. IIt is working with SETAs such as SSETA, PSETA, MQA, ETDP SETA, MerSETA, Services SETA and Bank SETA. The College has partnered with universities with the purpose of the articulation of students into higher education and also for resource sharing.

The economic activity in the area is characterized by small enterprises, e.g., agricultural activities, tourism and mining, car servicing, and welding; distributed among the rural settlement. Unemployment, poverty, and inequality are huge problems in this area. The unemployment rate is incredibly high, much more than the provincial average. There is shortage of infrastructure and big industries for the placement of students and lecturers.



Campus life

Campuses:

Vhembe TVET College has seven campuses, namely: Makwarela, Mavhoi, Mashamba, Shingwedzi, Thengwe, Tshisimani, Musina and Makhado Hospitality which is a satellite Centre. Each campus has its own identity but ensures the quality of teaching and learning is uniform across. Some campuses offer courses that are not found across the board, for example Primary Agriculture which can only be found at Mashamba Campus. Student Support Services:

Each campus has a Student Support Services representative whose main role or objective is to make campus life manageable for each student. They provide services such as assisting with registrations, career guidance and counselling (career and personal). SSS also manage sports, arts, and culture for their respective campuses, and they play a major role in ensuring that the College has a Student Representative Council that is fairly elected.

Programmes

Vhembe TVET College offers a variety of programmes under National Certificate Vocational (NCV) and NATED. We offer the following fields of studies: Engineering Studies, Business Studies, Occupational Programmes and Agricultural Courses. We also offer distance learning to cater for all youth and adults that can not be registered to attend daily.

Vhembe TVET College offers courses under Business Studies which allows students to focus on specialities such as Human Resource Management, Marketing, Accountancy, Finance and Hospitality Engineering Studies gives students understanding on how to solve the most impactful of our problems. Vhembe TVET College offers Engineering course that will assist students in constantly changing the world with innovations and solutions that affect everyone's life.

NATIONAL CERTIFICATE VOCATIONAL (NCV)

To enrol in the programme, prospective students should have the following:

- A year end school report for grade 9
- An NQF level 1 qualification, OR
- An approved bridging programme designed for the specific purpose to access NQF Level 2, OR
- A Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) assessment to meet basic requirements for access to NQF Level 2

With both studies, the College offers 3-year courses with each level making up 1 year i.e., Level 2 one year, Level 3 one year and Level 4 one year.

NATED (REPORT 190 / 191)

For prospective students to be able to qualify for the different courses under our NATED programmes, there are specific admission requirements which vary per programme.

Engineering studies:

A student must have a Senior certificate with at least three instructional offerings which are applicable to the course chosen OR N3 Engineering studies or higher.

Duration for any Engineering course under this programme is eleven weeks or Trimester per N-Level. Examinations are written at the end of each trimester, in other words in April, August and November.

A National Diploma is issued subject to the following:

- A minimum of twelve subjects is taken with at least three subjects on N4 – N6 Level, but no more than five N4 subjects.
- At least two N6 subjects that must have bearing on the vocation of the candidate
- Eighteen months of appropriate experiential training.

Business studies:

A student must have a Senior certificate/N3 or Grade 12 for N4, N5 and N6.

Duration for course under this programme is a semester of six months per N-Level. Examinations are written at the end of each semester, in other words in May/June and November/December.

A National Diploma is issued subject to the following:

- A minimum of twelve subjects is taken with at least three subjects on N4, N5 and N6 Level, but no more than five N4 subjects.
- At least two N6 subjects that must have bearing on the vocation of the candidate
- Eighteen months of appropriate experiential training.
